Depending on how you use the website, we may process the following personal data:

3. Purposes and legal bases for processing

We process personal data for the following purposes:

Responding to enquiries

When you contact us, we use the information provided to respond to your message and communicate with you.

The legal basis is taking steps at your request before entering into a contract, performance of a contract, or our legitimate interest in responding to professional and business enquiries.

Providing professional services

Where you request or receive services from us, personal data may be processed for preparing quotations, entering into and performing contracts, communicating about projects, issuing invoices, and maintaining business records.

The legal basis is performance of a contract, taking pre-contractual steps, and compliance with applicable legal obligations.

Website operation and security

Technical information may be processed to operate the website, prevent misuse, identify technical problems, and maintain website and information security.

The legal basis is our legitimate interest in operating a secure and functional website.

Analytics and non-essential cookies

Where analytics, marketing, or other non-essential technologies are enabled, they will be used on the basis of your consent where consent is legally required. You may withdraw or change your consent through the cookie settings available on the website.

Legal compliance

We may process and retain information where necessary to comply with accounting, tax, regulatory, legal, or other statutory obligations.

4. Wix hosting and service providers
